The mobile sector makes a substantial contribution to Pakistani government revenues. It accounted for 7 percent of the \$31.5 billion in tax revenue collected in 2013. It is significant to know that while high taxation on the mobile sector may deliver short-term benefits for government but in the long- term it is unfavorable.

As per SBP data, there were nearly 2 million registered mobile banking users in Pakistan as of December 2015. These numbers have been gradually increasing. During the September-December quarter last year, mobile banking users initiated some 1.5 million transactions depicting a massive population of mobile bankers. Nearly Rs. 24 billion rupees moved in the banking system thanks to mobile banking that quarter.

Besides there were about 13 million non-financial transactions using mobile banking channels, the value of which is unreported by the SBP. No doubt mobile sector in Pakistan has enabled millions of people to be connected and have access to latest information.

Mobile industry has the potential to increase the economic and social development of Pakistan in order to meet the objectives of PTA Vision 2025. According to GSMA Intelligence and World Bank report, 1 percent increase in mobile penetration can lead to a 0.28 percent increase in the GDP growth rate of Pakistan. World Bank indicated that every 10 percent increase in mobile broadband penetration can accelerate the economic growth of middle-income countries up to 1.38 percent.
